RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF RESOLUTION 02-03-21-1 & RESTAT-ING SUPPORT TO APPLY FOR LRIP FUNDING FOR ROADWORK ON QUEENS ROAD, AVON, STEARNS COUNTY, MN

WHEREAS, the Avon Township Board of Supervisors passed Resolution 02-03-21-3 to Apply for Funding for Roadwork on Queens Road, Avon, Stearns County, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, there has been little Township action in the past 2.5 years regarding Queens Road because the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MNDOT) LRIP was inactive and not accepting proposals for road projects; and

WHEREAS, Queens Road is heavily trafficked because motorists use this road as a way to bypass the City of Avon, is a major thoroughfare to the City of St. Cloud, serves multiple farmers who move heavy machinery along this route, serves a commercial farm-to-market operation, and is in need of significant repair; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) administered by MNDOT now makes funds available to apply towards projects on local roads that are regionally significant, result in safety improvements, and address transportation deficiencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Avon Township, Stearns County, Minnesota, restates its support of Resolution 02-03-21-3; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Avon Township Board of Supervisors supports submitting an application to the 2023 LRIP program administered by MNDOT to resurface Queens Road, Stearns County, Minnesota,
