RESOLUTION NO. 01-02-20-3

RESOLUTION APPROVING STATE OF MINNESOTA JOINT POWERS AGREEMENTS WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF AVON ON BEHALF OF ITS PROSECUTING ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, the Township of Avon on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney desires to enter into a Joint Powers Agreement with the State of Minnesota, Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to use systems and tools available over the State's criminal justice data communications network for which the Township is eligible. The Joint Powers Agreement further provides the Township with the ability to add, modify and delete connectivity, systems and tools over the five-year life of the agreement and obligates the Township to pay the costs for the network connection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Board of Avon, Minnesota as follows:

1. That the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreement by and between the State of Minnesota acting through its Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and the Township of Avon on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney, are hereby approved. A Copy of the Joint Powers Agreement is attached to this Resolution and made a part of it.
2. That the County Attorney, Janelle P. Kendall, or her successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Prosecuting Attorney. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the State of Minnesota to maintain the Township's connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.
3. That Mike Linn, the Board Chair for the Township of Avon (or his successor), and Stephen Saupe (or his successor), the Township Clerk, are authorized to sign the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements.
