2025 Project Overview



Avon Township is planning to resurface approximately 1.6 miles of Queens Road from County Road 9 to a point approximately a half mile north of County Road 155 (as shown on map below) this Summer. Knife River Corporation will be the contractor in charge of the work. The work is scheduled to begin this coming week and the Contractors will be reclaiming the existing bituminous surfacing, re-grading, and then paving a new bituminous surface. The current roadway width is being maintained.

Access to your driveway should be maintained during the project with only some short term delays if the Contractor's grading or paving equipment is working past your property.

The project work is expected to take approximately two to three weeks.

- Garbage pickup and mail delivery should not be impacted by the project. The Contractor will work to keep access for these services during the work.
